# COVID 19 REQUIREMENTS

## EXHIBITORS ONLY – NO SPECTATORS

1. Per the Park's COVID-19 requirements, we are **limited to no more than 50 people** on site at a time. Due to the restrictions by the Town of Wickenburg - this is a **No Spectator - Show** venue. Please do not bring your family and friends if they are not exhibiting a dog.
2. **Masks Are REQUIRED**, over the nose and mouth while on the Show Grounds; including the parking lots. Mask must be worn at all times including in the ring. If you can't do this - PLEASE DON'T COME.
3. **Social Distancing REQUIRED** – You must keep a safe space distance of at least 6 feet between yourself and others. This applies to all areas including grooming areas, ring and parking lots.
4. There will be **no hospitality food** provided for exhibitors due to COVID-19. The club will provide bottled water. See lunch options on page 10.
5. If you are sick, have a fever or cough or have been exposed to someone who is sick - PLEASE DON'T COME.
6. At the Show Committee's discretion, your temperature will be checked. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be excused from the Show and must leave the park immediately.
7. Hairdryer are not allowed in the grooming spaces in the pavilion.
8. **Exhibitor Arm Bands** will be available **30 minutes** before scheduled show time at the ring. **Know your arm band numbers**, exhibitor will not have access to Steward Catalog.
9. There will be a designated **Enter** and **Exit** gate for the ring.
10. **Ribbons and Trophies** will be placed on table near the EXIT of the ring and will NOT be handed out by Judge
11. Every exhibitor/worker/person associated with the show will be **REQUIRED to sign the COVID-19 Liability Release Waiver** when you arrive at the show ground. At that time, you will receive a **wristband** for the two-day show. The wristband must be worn while on the Show Grounds.

Please complete waiver prior to coming to show. Bring your signed waiver with you to the check in table where you will receive a **wristband**. Extra copies will be available at check in table.

**NOTE:** Check In table will be accepting waivers starting at **8:00 am** each day.



## COVID-19 Liability Release Waiver

**This is for exhibitors, owners, handlers, breeders, assistants, worker, etc. If you are on the grounds, a form signed by you must be on file.**

The World Health Organization has declared the novel Coronavirus (COVID- 19) a worldwide pandemic. Due to its capacity to transmit from person-to-person through respiratory droplets, the government has set recommendations, guidelines, and some prohibitions which Cactus State Miniature Schnauzer Club Inc and Town of Wickenburg adhere to.

In consideration of my participation in the foregoing, the undersigned acknowledge and agree to the following:

- I am aware of the existence of the risk to my physical well-being that participation in the Cactus State Miniature Schnauzer Club Show and presence at this venue may present. That risk may include but is not limited to influenza, MRSA, COVID-19 and could result in serious maladies including death.
- I have not experienced symptoms of fever, fatigue, difficulty in breathing, or dry cough or exhibiting any other symptoms relating to COVID-19 or any communicable disease within the last 14 days. Following the pronouncements above I hereby declare the following:
- I am fully and personally responsible for my own safety and actions during my participation and I recognize that I may be in any case at risk of contracting COVID-19.
- With full knowledge of the risks involved, I hereby release, waive, discharge The Organization, its board, officers, independent contractors, affiliates, employees, representatives, successors, and assigns from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, or death, that may be sustained by me related to COVID-19 while participating in any activity while in, on, or around the premises or while using the facilities that may lead to unintentional exposure or harm due to COVID-19.

## GROOMING SPACES

A chart of the assigned Grooming Spaces will be posted as you enter the Pavilion. Your name will also appear in your spot. Spaces are 6 feet apart for social distancing. A safe place for overnight storage of your grooming table(s) and supplies will be available in the adjoining building.

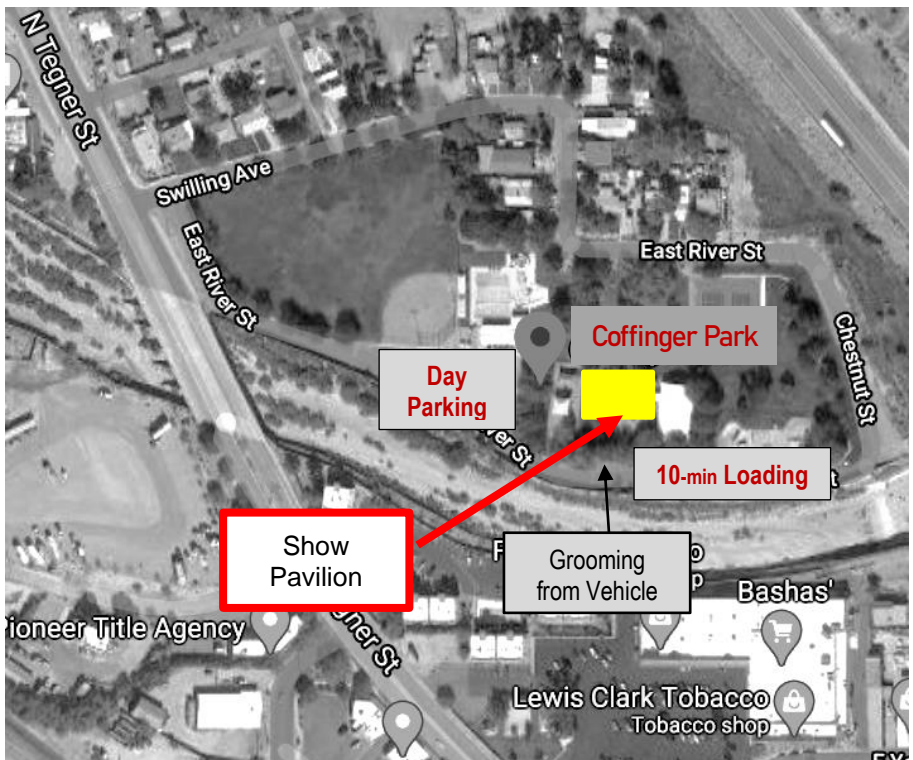
